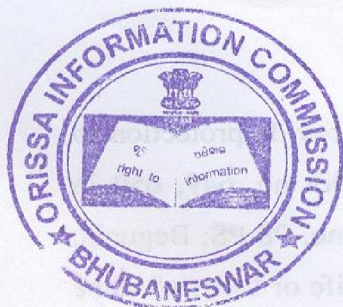

Decision

- 1 Complainant Shri Umesh Prasad is present. Heard him. Perused the case record.
- 2 The Complainant had initially moved the State Commission on the ground of danger to "Life or Liberty" which, however, he could not substantiate during the hearing on 17/01/07. Furthermore, form A application dated 27/12/06 was not submitted, as required under the Orissa Right To Information Rules, 2005. Regardless of these infirmities he was given a chance for hearing on 27/02/07 when also he did not submit the form A application.


- 3 From the form A application dated 27/12/06 submitted today it is seen that he wanted to know from the PIO, Office of DG and IG of Police, Orissa, Cuttack the current status and action taken on his petition dated 14/12/06 filed with DG, Orissa which concerns his life or liberty.
- 4 He further mentioned that his solitary request was to provide protection to his ancestral bungalow in Mouza Chimma in Sabik Plot no. 649, 650 in khata no. 152, 159, and Hal Plot no. 840, 839 in khata no. 98 PS, Begunia, Khurda District. This he mentioned was his issue of "Life or Liberty" as he is not able to enter and occupy the house.
- 5 The State Commission after hearing the Complainant are of the view that the request made by him is not within the ambit of the RTI Act, 2005. However, the State Commission direct that his form A application dated 27/12/06 be communicated to DG and IG of Police, Orissa, State Police Headquarters, Cuttack for taking necessary action as per the relevant law. The Complainant took note of this order.
- 6 Hence the case is disposed of and closed.
