**Decision**

1. Complainant, Shri Ramakanta Mahapatra is present. PIO Shri Ajaya Kumar Das with APIO, Shri Manas Ranjan Lenka and Ms. Madhumita Swain and the First Appellate Authority-cum-Senior

General Manager (Finance), Shri Debasish Saha of Orissa Power Transmission Corporation Limited, Janpath, Bhubaneswar are present. At the request of the Complainant this Complaint Case which stood posted to 21/08/07 was advanced to today with the consent of the OPs. The request was accepted as there were two other cases of the Complainant listed for today wherein both sides were common. Heard both sides. Perused all the relevant records.

2. The Complainant in his form A application dated 19/05/06 had sought for information on issues like payment of salary, allowances and service conditions. He had also sought for a copy of the decision of the Board, if any, regarding the following subject:- “whether any proposal (was made) to the committee of the Board under Regulation 7 (seven) of GRIDCO Officers Service regulations submitted and if so a copy of the decisions taken may kindly be supplied.”
3. The OPs submitted to have provided the information to the Complainant within the stipulated time. Their submission is corroborated from the official letter no.8207 dated 03/06/07 sent by the PIO to the Complainant. He has very clearly mentioned in the

said letter that "no such proposal has been placed before the committee of the Board under regulation 7 (Seven) of GRIDCO officers service regulations and hence no decision".

4. In view of the above discussed facts and circumstances it is noticed that this case of the Complainant is not founded on any merit and hence dismissed. Both parties took note of this decision pronounced in the open forum.
