**Decision**

1. Appellant Shri Pravat Kumar Mishra, PIO, Shri Ajaya Kumar Singh, PIO-cum-Deputy Superintendent of Police and First Appellate Authority Shri Sanjeeb Panda, IPS Superintendent of Police, Puri are present. Heard. Perused the case record.
2. Appellant had sought for information in form A application dated 17/07/06 from the PIO, office of the Superintendent of Police, Puri regarding action by the Superintendent of Police, Puri in implementing order dated 15/09/2004 passed by Justice B.P. Das of Orissa High Court in W.P. (crl) No.182/2004.

3. The PIO mentioned that on receipt of the application of the Appellant, it was sent to the concerned section in the District Superintendent of Police office, as he did not deal with the matter. The information as received from the Crime Section was then passed on in a letter dated 09/08/06 to the Appellant in good faith. However, at a subsequent stage, the Appellant preferred first appeal in form D dated 14/08/06 before Superintendent of Police, Puri seeking clarification on the information given to him.
4. The First Appellate Authority explained the position and submitted the relevant documents to the State Commission, viz copies of letter no.3652 dated 05/10/04 and letter no. 6119 dated 11/09/06 given to the Appellant. He also mentioned that action was taken by them on 05/10/04 on the orders dated 15/09/04 of the Orissa High Court in W.P. (crl) no. 182/04.
5. The Appellant was advised that as he has received all the required information matter is closed. No delay is noticed. Hence no order on penalty.
