Decision


1. Complainant Pranati Tripathy is absent. The same is condoned under Rule 9 (2) of the Orissa Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2006. Kedarnath Acharya, PIO, Directorate of Secondary Education, Orissa, Bhubaneswar is present. Heard. Perused the case record.
2. It reveals from the record that the Complainant had sought information in form A application dated 18/01/07 from the PIO, Directorate of Secondary Education, Orissa regarding approval of Assistant Teacher (TGT Arts) posted in Sevashram Sanskrit Vidyapitha, Phulbani (Kandhamal District).
3. The case was last heard on 19/02/08. The PIO had stated that the Complainant had not furnished proof of identity alongwith her form A

application. She subsequently supplied the same on 23/02/07. He had also stated that the relevant file on the subject could not be located in their office. This matter was reported by Section Officer (Section-VI) on 26/02/07 to the PIO. The record keeper was also asked to search for the file bearing no. 05T-124-VI/99. The latter submitted a final report that the said file was not available in the record room even after thorough search. Thereafter the Complainant was intimated vide letter no. 14910 dated 22/03/07 that the relevant file was not traceable in their office. Subsequently, collecting the information from the Superintendent of Sanskrit Studies, Orissa, Puri, the same was provided, free of cost, to the Complainant vide letter no. 26604 dated 23/05/07. This initiative was appreciated.

4. The Complainant was intimated on 20/03/08 by the State Commission to clarify whether she has received the required information or not. She had neither raised any objection in writing nor appeared in person or through any representative. Presumably, she has received the information sought.
5. In view of the above and as there was no delay in the initial communication the case is disposed of and closed. Inform the Complainant
