Decision

1. Appellant Renubala Moharana is absent, but is represented by Gopabandhu Moharana by way of an authorization letter dated 19/11/08. The same was accepted. Gadadhar Panda ,PIO-cum-Deputy Director, Orissa, Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation (for brevity IDCO), Bhubaneswar is also present. Heard. Perused the case record. This matter arises out of second appeal in form E dated 18/06/07 and categorized as SA 127/2007 and SA 239/2007 under Section 19 (3) of the RTI Act, 2005.
2. The representative of the Complainant made an elaborate presentation, with reference to several correspondences, which was heard in extenso.

During hearing of these two similar second appeal petitions, the Complainant's representative elaborately referred to the facts and orders in CC no. 419/07. He stated that the form A application dated 15/01/07 had been filed with the PIO, IDCO, Bhubaneswar seeking information relating to "Service matter:-Absorption/ Regularization of Graduate Architects (Trainee) of IDCO" and other related issues.

3. PIO, IDCO stated that all the required information have been supplied on 30/01/08 to the Complainant (Appellant in these two cases) in compliance to the orders of the State Commission in C.C. no.419/07 which has been disposed of. He filed a photocopy of the acknowledgement receipt signed on 30/01/08 by Renubala Moharana, which was taken to record. The fact of receipt of information was confirmed by her representative today.
4. From the averments made by the both the parties and perusal of both the form E second appeals on record, it is clear that another instituted case bearing no.C.C. 419/07 for the same relief has been disposed of and closed after hearing both parties on 25/01/08 with necessary orders and compliance thereto has also been reported. As multiplicity of cases/ proceedings cannot be encouraged for the same matter/issues, these cases are not maintainable. Hence they are disposed of and closed.
